Show Requirements

Health Requirement: Negative Coggins test (within 12 months) required for all showing & non-showing horses.

Riding Attire: All riders must wear an ASTM/SEI certified helmet as well as appropriate riding attire at all times while mounted at Cadence Equestrian Center.

Liability Waiver: All parents of minors, and/or riders 18 & over must sign a liability waiver prior to riding at Cadence Equestrian Center.

Horse Welfare: Show management reserves the right to limit showing or schooling if it is believed to be in the best interest of a horse's welfare.

Show Fees

Office Fee: \$25 per horse/rider combination

Medic Fee: \$10 per horse/rider combination

Non-Showing and/or Schooling Fee: \$50 per day (non-showing horses only)

Stall Fee: \$75 in barn includes light bedding; \$30 per show day in the field (stalls available after 2 p.m. on Friday)

Shavings: \$10 per bag – must be pre-ordered to guarantee availability (outside shavings are permitted).

All Medal Classes: \$25

Hunter or Jumper Classic: \$50

Warm up, hunter, equitation, and jumper classes: \$19

Horse Show Class & Division Specifications

Cadence Special Classes & Divisions

Cadence special classes are classes that do not accrue points for HJEO, OHJA or TIP. Open to all riders per the specifications.

Warm Up Hunter: Jump heights will be the same as the classes running concurrently.

Leadline: For 7 and under riders. May not cross enter into any other class at the show. An adult or older child leads the horse in-hand while the rider is judged on his/her equitation.

Mini Stirrup Walk Trot: Riders are judged on their equitation at the walk and trot on the flat and over poles on ground. May not cross enter into any other division.

Trot Crossbar: Open to non-professional riders who have not competed in classes in 2'6 or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, GO or USEF recognized show. Entries will trot a course of cross rails at 12". Not to canter in the under saddle.

Canter Crossbar: Open to non-professional riders who have not competed in classes in 2'6 or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, GO or USEF recognized show. Entries will canter a course of cross rails at 12". Not to canter in the under saddle.

HJEO /OHJA Schooling Divisions & Tip Divisions

(Details and specifics of bylaws may be found on the HJEO & OHJA websites.)

Short Stirrup Hunter & Equitation: Open to non-professional riders, age ten and under who have not competed in any classes with fences 2'6" or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or USEF recognized show. Not open for riders who have won year-end champion or reserve in HJEO or OHJA in Short Stirrup or Academy Short/Long Stirrup divisions. Fences not to exceed 18". Trotting jumps or lead changes not to be penalized. Canter is prohibited in under saddle classes. To be judged on manner of going, jumping style, correct pace, and organization.

Long Stirrup Hunter & Equitation: Open to non-professional riders, age 11 and over who have not competed in any classes with fences 2'6" or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or USEF recognized shows. Riders may not have won year-end Champion or Reserve in HJEO or OHJA in short stirrup, long stirrup or academy short/long stirrup divisions. Fence not to exceed 18". Trotting jumps or lead changes not to be penalized. Canter is prohibited in under saddle classes. To be judged on manner of going, jumping style, correct pace, and organization.

Academy Short/Long Stirrup Hunter & Equitation: Open to any non-professional rider that has not competed in classes with fences 2'6" or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or USEF recognized shows. Riders may not have won year-end champion or reserve in HJEO or OHJA in Short Stirrup, Long Stirrup or Academy Short/Long Stirrup divisions. Must compete on an Academy Horse as defined by HJEO By-Laws, Article IV, section 12. Fences not to exceed 18". Trotting jumps or lead changes is not to be penalized. Cantering is prohibited in under saddle classes. To be judged on manners, way of going, jumping style, correct pace, and organization.

Open 2' Hunter & Equitation: Open to professional and non-professional riders. Fence heights are not to exceed 2'. Trotting lead changes is not to be penalized. Cantering is prohibited in under saddle classes. Equitation classes open only to non-professional riders who have not competed in any classes with fences 2'6" or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or USEF recognized shows. This is an open division created for green horses and/or green riders not yet ready to move up to the 2'3" height. To be judged on manners, way of going, jumping style, and suitability for the Beginner Rider. Because this is an open division, correct leads and a consistent number of strides may be considered, but simple lead changes are not penalized.

Child/Adult Beginner Hunter & Equitation: Open to non-professional riders who have not competed in classes with fences 2'9" or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or USEF recognized shows. Riders may not have won year-end champion or reserve in HJEO or OHJA in Beginner or Academy Beginner divisions. Fences at 2'3".

Open 2'3" Hunter: Open to professional and non-professional riders. Fences at 2'3".

Child/Adult Academy Beginner Hunter & Equitation: Open to non-professional riders who have not competed in any classes with fences 2'9" or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or USEF recognized show. Riders may not have won year end champion or reserve in HJEO or OHJA in Beginner or Academy Beginner divisions. Must compete on an Academy Horse as defined in HJEO By-Laws, Article IV, section 12.

Open 2'6" Hunter: Open to professional and non-professional riders. Fences at 2'6".

Child/Adult Intermediate Hunter & Equitation: Open to non-professional riders who have not competed in classes with fences 3' or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or USEF recognized show. Riders who have won year end champion or reserve in HJEO or OHJA in the Intermediate divisions. Fences at 2'6".

T.I.P. Special Thoroughbred: Eligible horses must provide T.I.P. Numbers to show secretary with entry. T.I.P. ribbons for first through sixth place for each class and Champion/Reserve ribbons & Champion prize will be provided. For more information visit www.tjctip.com. Fences at 2'6".

Child/Adult Modified Hunter & Equitation: Open to non-professional riders. Fences at 2'9".

3' Open Hunter: Open to all riders. Fences at 3'.

Hopeful Jumpers: Fences .75m

Puddle Jumpers: Fences .85m

Thoroughbred Incentive Program (Tip) Jumpers: Fences .85m

Future Jumpers: Fences .90m - .95m

\$100 Child/Adult Hunter Classic: Offered at 2'3" w/ 2'6" options, 2'6" with 2'9" options and 2'9" with 3' options over a course of 8-12. Bonus points for high options. Prize money is divided \$30, \$22, \$15, \$12, \$11, \$10.

\$100 Child/Adult Jumper Classic: Offered at .75m & .85m, Table II.2.b. In the Jump Off .85m a two second advantage, and no advantage for .75m. Prize money is divided \$30, \$22, \$15, \$12, \$11, \$10.

HJEO/OHJA MEDAL CLASSES

HJEO Mini Medal: Riders must be current HJEO members. The class is open to eligible beginner and intermediate riders showing 2'6". The class must have a minimum of three riders and only one horse per rider. Fences set at 2'6". Riders must be entered in both the intermediate equitation O/F class and the HJEO Mini Medal. The class will be run as a regular equitation O/F round with an equitation style test to commence immediately after the last fence of the intermediate round is jumped. Test will be limited to USEF Equitation tests 1-9. First and second place winners are qualified for the HJEO Mini Medal Ride-Off. All qualified may continue to show in the mini medal for the remainder of the year.

OHJA 3' Medal: Riders must be current OHJA members. The OHJA 3' Medal Class is open to Junior and Amateur riders. The class will consist of a course of at least eight obstacles with heights at 3' and spreads to 3' and will have at least one oxer and two changes in direction (lead). Additional tests (tests 1-14) of the top two to six riders are required. Riders must not have won the OHJA 3' Medal Class during the current Competition Year or the OHJA 3' Medal Ride-Off.

OHJA Beginner Medal: Riders must be current OHJA members. Class Requirements A minimum of three riders must compete to fill the class. Riders show over a figure-eight course of at least eight obstacles with heights at 2'3" and spreads to 2'3". The course will have at least one oxer and two changes in direction (lead). Additional tests (tests 1-9) of the top four to six riders are required. Must be a crossbar or beginner level rider as of December 1 of the previous year (beginning of current show year). Not open (for judging) to any rider who prior to the current competition year rode in any class with fence heights 2'6" or higher at any USEF, OHJA or HJEO show. No professional riders will be allowed to enter. Riders must not ride in any 2'9" or higher equitation class at the same show. Riders who place qualify for the OHJA Beginner Medal Ride-Off.

O RATED DIVISIONS

Child Hunter: Fences 3'. Open to children.

Adult Hunter: Fences 3'. Open to adult amateurs.

Performance Hunter: Fences 3'3". Open to all riders at any age.

Child/Adult Jumper: Fences 1m. Open to children or adult amateurs.

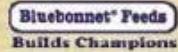



