General Information

Entries

Entries close at 4 p.m. November 17, 2021. Post entries will be accepted until the close of the show office the day before the classes are held at regular cost plus a one-time late charge of \$50. Riders who show in a class in which they are not entered will be charged \$10

Horses must be named on the entry blank, including horses shown only in equitation classes. Give complete name, address, telephone number and taxpayer ID number for owner, rider and trainer. It's the responsibility of the person making the entry to properly complete necessary information for each entry made in accordance with the rules of HJEO.

Entries will only be accepted when signed by the owner, rider or handler and trainer and must be accompanied by a check for stabling fees.

Numbers will not be issued without proof of a negative EIA (Coggins) test.

A \$50 office/administration fee and a \$20 medic fee will be charged for every horse on the show grounds to cover schooling and entry changes.

Tack stalls and shavings can be divided if notification is given in the show office no later than Friday at noon.

Non-showing horses will be charged \$75 in addition to the non-refundable office and medic fee and the owner must submit a signed entry blank and show proof of negative Coggins test.

All billing discrepancies must be handled within 24 hours of the completion of the show. Any exhibitor leaving the show with unpaid charges will be billed and a fee of \$50 will be added to the total due.

Refunds

No stall/office fees will be refunded after the closing date. Entry fees will not be refunded unless a certificate of illness or injury prepared by a veterinarian is presented before the start of the show. Once the show has started, horses that are not shown in classes which they have entered will forfeit their entry fees, except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the class entered and a certificate of illness from the official horse show veterinarian required. Proper notification of scratches must be made in the show office before the start of the class or classes being scratched. In either case the entry fee will be refunded less an office processing charge of \$50. Refunds will be credited to the show bill and any credit due (prize money) will be mailed within 30 days of the completion of the show only if the refund/prize money recipient information is filled out completely so be certain the office has all the correct information in legible form.

Non-Negotiable Payments

Exhibitors who issue non-negotiable checks will be charged an additional \$100 for each time the check is returned by the bank. HJEO reserves the right to bar competitors who have issued bad checks previously. Competitors with a history of returned checks to HJEO or its member barns will need to pay by cash or money order all show fees plus a \$200 deposit upon checking in to the horse show office before being issued an entry number and being allowed to show.

Stalls

Stalls are 10' x 10' permanent stalls with doors and are \$150 if postmarked or paid for and entries are submitted by November 1, 2021. After November 1, 2021, stalls are \$200. Accurate classes must be entered on entries for early stall price. This allows us to be sure we can run the show as efficiently as possible and not have to change the schedule significantly during the show. Permanent stalls are on a first come basis. Stalls are available Tuesday before the start of the show. Each entry with a horse stall is required to purchase a minimum of four bags of bedding through the show office. Additional bedding, feed and hay are available for purchase on the grounds. Manure must be disposed of in designated areas only, no manure in trash bins. Removal of stall panels and/ or doors will be charged a fee by the facility through the horse show office. A \$60 per day grounds fee will be charged for all horses on the grounds if not purchasing a stall.

Credentials

Exhibitors in amateur, junior or pony sections must present an amateur certificate or horse measurement card to the show office before numbers will be released. To speed processing, please send a photocopy of those credentials with your entry.

Attire

Riders must be properly attired with show numbers clearly visible. Protective headgear must be worn and fastened by riders at all times while mounted anywhere, anytime on the show grounds. Headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry the SEI tag, and be properly secured by a harness per USEF rules.

Ribbons/Trophies/Championships

Class placings receive ribbons from first through eighth place. Each section will receive a champion and reserve award on points. Full championship points will be given in hunter sections. In hunter sections, champion and reserve will be awarded to two of the top four horses acquiring the most points over fences. These four horses will also receive full points for the under-saddle class.

Jumpers

Ties in jumper classes will jump off for first place only. Ties for all other places will be determined by fastest time in the first round among those with an equal number of faults. Ties for champion and reserve champion will remain tied.

Jump Order/Ring Conflicts

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to follow jump orders and check in when necessary. Management will designate priority rings on a daily basis. Paddock masters have the authority to scratch exhibitors not in compliance with this policy. Add/scratch slips must be presented to the paddock master prior to class start.

Footing & Arena Dimensions

Ford Arena is 150' x 300", Mustang Ring is 125' x 225'.

Schooling

Rings will be open for schooling one day prior to their start. Rings will also be open before the show each day for hacking. Times will be posted or announced. Free, supervised schooling will be permitted Thursday after the completion of the show until the latter of 6 p.m. or one hour after jump crew is through setting fences for the next day. All other schooling times will be announced daily. Once the supervised schooling is completed, hacking only will be allowed in the rings.

Dogs

Dogs are not permitted to be loose on the competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to a penalty.

Golf Carts/Motorized Vehicles

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent, legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent, guardian and/or trainer who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent, guardian, and/or trainer from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Courses

Will be posted an hour prior to classes. Hunter courses are designed to simulate fences found in the hunting field such as brush, wall, oxer, gates etc. In some cases, the courtesy circle may be restricted by a dotted line on the course diagram & physically in the ring. Classes are judged on performance & soundness unless otherwise noted. Sections with few competitors may be combined and any section with fewer than six may be canceled.

Sharps Containers

The competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

Changes

Management reserves the right to make changes to its list of officials and/or to cancel, combine, add, delay, and reschedule classes in the best interest of the event and its operations.

Warning

Under Oklahoma law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of mequine activities.

Animal Welfare

We require that all horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion and should never be subject to mistreatment. Owners, trainers, riders and grooms, or their agents must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of their horses whether owned or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose. At all times, while the horse is on the show grounds, we will provide for the continuous well-being of the horse by enforcing the rules of the USEF which pertain to this subject. USEF rules defining policy regarding abuse and use of whips will be strictly enforced. No poling, use of bamboo offset or excessive use of the whip will be tolerated. The well-being of the horse must be considered above the demands of the breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organizers, sponsors or officials. Violators may be subject to penalties pursuant to USEF rules. In the event of an acute and serious injury to or illness of a horse on competition grounds when the owner or trainer of the horse or agent of the owner is not present, after reasonable effort to contact that individual has been made, competition management, in consultation with a licensed equine veterinarian, may authorize the provision of emergency veterinary treatment of the horse. If competition management so authorizes treatment under the provisions of this rule, competition management and veterinarian are not liable for any resulting costs, damages, losses, claims or actions arising directly or indirectly from the treatment of the horse.

Responsibility

Submission of entry to this show constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Tulsa Expo Center, Hunter Jumper Exhibitors of Oklahoma (HJEO) and the horse show officials against any claims, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of exhibitor's business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of exhibitor of any conditions of this agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against Tulsa Expo Center and show management by reason of any such claim exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action or proceeding by counsel acceptable to owner, exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and Tulsa Expo Center and show management are not responsible for accidents, fire, or theft.

1. The HJEO Derby will run in two rounds at 2'6'' or 2'9'' – riders declare which. The first round of the derby is a hunter round. The second round is a handy hunter round.

2. Derbies will not have combinations or any lines shorter than a four-stride to allow ponies and horses to do the added step.

3. The top twelve will come back for the second round.

4. The derby is open to all non-pro riders except for any horse & rider combination that rides in a derby or classic worth \$5000 or more during the show season.

5. Points are accrued by the horse for the year end derby meaning another rider can ride that horse in the year-end derby.

602. Mid-West Equitation Finals • Entry Fee: \$75

Open to all junior, amateur, children's and adult riders competing in classes at this show. Must be an HJEO member. This class is comprised of four phases, all to be judged on horsemanship skills. Each phase will receive a numerical score and all phase scores are totaled for the final overall score. Ribbons are awarded from first to sixth place in each phase and first to tenth for the combined total scores.

Individual phases may be entered. The four sections are:

602a. Mid-West Written Phase

A multiple-choice exam testing knowledge of basic horsemanship skills.

602b Practicum Phase

Horse and rider shall be presented to the judge tacked to enter the show ring or any other way as specified by the judge. A one on-one interview and review of skills involving horsemanship and general equine knowledge will be demonstrated to the judge.

602c Flat Phase

Group work on the rail which may include tests 1-18. "Last man standing format"meaning at the judge's discretion the lower scoring riders after each test are pulled into the middle of the arena until the final two are left, in which the judge may offer further testing.

602d Over Fence Phase

Equitation type course. Fences are set at 3' and 3'6" The rider must declare the height at which they will jump at the start of the show.

Stable Style Equitation Challenge • Entry Fee \$50

This is a four-phase Equitation Challenge which is based on the Mid West Equitation Finals format used at the HJEO Fall Finale. It is open to all junior amateur riders showing in divisions 2'9" and below with equitation classes.

The four phases are:

- A. Equitation Over Fences (points from rider's division equitation over fences)
- B. Equitation on the Flat (points from rider's division equitation flat)
- C. Written Test (taken in the office on Saturday before 2 p.m.)
- D. Practicum (time and place to be announced)

There will be winners in each division as well as an overall winner. This class gives riders a chance to practice equitation and horsemanship to prepare for the Mid-West Equitation Finals Champion- ship at this show. All proceeds directly benefit HJEO year-end awards.

604 HJEO Hunter Ride-Off • No Entry Fee

Must enter at office This class is designed for beginner and intermediate riders and is open to non-professional members of HJEO. They must be in the top ten point earners for the year in the Beginner or Intermediate Hunters. To be shown over a figure-eight course of eight jumps set at 2'6". There is open numerical scoring. The top 12 return in the second round.

Open to riders who are current OHJA members. There must be a minimum of three riders for the class to count. A figure-eight course of eight obstacles at 2'6" with spreads to 2'6" with at least one oxer and two changes of direction (lead). Additional tests 1-9 of the top 4 to 6 riders is required. Awards are a gold medal, provided by OHJA, and six placing ribbons. All riders that place qualify for the OHJA Mini-Medal Ride-Off.

701 OHJA Mini Medal Ride Off • No Entry Fee

Must enter at office. There must be a minimum of three riders for the class to count. Open to OHJA members who placed in any OHJA Mini-Medal class during the current show year. To be shown over an equitation, figure-eight type course of eight obstacles at 2'6" with spreads to 2'6" with at least one oxer and two changes of direction (lead). Only the equitation counts. Additional testing of the top 4 to 6 riders required. Tests 1-9. Awards are a gold medal and ribbons through eighth place.

702 OHJA 3' Medal Qualifier • Entry Fee: \$40

Open to riders who are current OHJA members. There must be a minimum of three riders for the class to count. A figure-eight course of at least eight obstacles at 3' with spreads to 3' with at least one oxer and two changes of direction (lead). Additional tests 1-14 of the top 2 to 6 riders is required. Riders must be OHJA nonprofessional riders and may not ride in any 3'6" or higher equitation class at the show. Awards are a gold medal, provided by OHJA, and six placing ribbons. All riders that place qualify for the OHJA 3' Medal Ride-Off.

703 OHJA 3' Medal Ride-Off • No Entry Fee

Must enter at office. There must be a minimum of three riders for the class to count. Open to OHJA members who placed in any OHJA 3' Medal class during the current show year. A figure-eight course of at least eight obstacles at 3' with spreads to 3' with at least one oxer and two changes of direction (lead). Additional tests 1-14 of the top 2 to 6 riders is required. Riders must be OHJA nonprofessional riders and may not ride in any 3'6" or higher equitation class at the show. Equitation only to count. Tests 1-14 of the top 2 to 6 riders required. See OHJA Specs. Awards are a gold medal and ribbons through eighth place.

704 OHJA 3'3" Medal Qualifier • Entry Fee: \$40

Open to riders who are current OHJA members. There must be a minimum of three riders for the class to count. A figure-eight course of at least eight obstacles at 3'3" with spreads to 3'3" with at least one oxer and two changes of direction (lead). Additional tests 1-14 of the top 2 to 6 riders is required. Riders must be OHJA nonprofessional riders and may not ride in any 3'6" or higher equitation class at the show. Awards are a gold medal, provided by OHJA, and six placing ribbons. All riders that place qualify for the Oklahoma 3'3" Medal Ride-Off.

705 OHJA 3'3" Medal Ride-Off

Must enter at office. There must be a minimum of three riders for the class to count. Open to OHJA members who placed in any Oklahoma 3'3" medal class during the current show year. A figure-eight course of at least eight obstacles at 3'3" with spreads to 3'3" with at least one oxer and two changes of direction (lead). Additional tests 1-14 of the top 2 to 6 riders is required. Riders must be OHJA nonprofessional riders and may not ride in any 3'6" or higher equitation class at the show. Equitation only to count. Tests 1-14 of the top 2 to 6 riders required. See OHJA Specs. Awards are a gold medal and ribbons through eighth place.


