COVID-19 Response

The following are the changes we have made to better ensure the safety of our patrons and employees in light of the current COVID-19 guidelines:

- We have elected to run a one-day show on Saturday utilizing our large jumping arena and the smaller upper arena. In order to minimize the number of people in warm-up areas, we will utilize the small lower warmup arena, the large indoor arena, and in addition one of our large paddocks for hacking.
- Entries will be taken in the same general office area and we encourage online entries (www.horseshowsonline.com). Tables will be placed across the entrance so that no exhibitors will be indoors. The bathroom at the show office will be closed.
- Bathrooms will be open in barn one and the former Parents Hospitality Suite adjacent to the indoor arena. Bathrooms will be cleaned and disinfected regularly. You may wish to bring your own sanitizing wipes and spray.
- Barns one and two will be closed to all but boarders and those renting overnight stalls. **No chairs or seating in the barn aisles.** Entry to barn one will be allowed to access the bathroom.
- The indoor arena is limited to 3 riders at one time.
- Social distancing is required in the bleachers for the upper arena and the indoor arena. Face masks are strongly recommended in the indoor arena, barns, and any indoor area.
- Mounted riders may ride and/or compete in the ring with or without a mask. The use of gloves is recommended.
- Exhibitors who have recently been ill or suspect they might be ill, should stay home. If you have come in contact with someone that has been ill, we ask you to stay home.
- We recommend the use of face coverings and social distancing in any of our indoor facilities. Extra sanitizing stations will be set up throughout the barns and outdoor facilities.
- Please be mindful of our gate and office staff. We ask that if you need to talk to any of them, that you wear a mask. Social distancing is difficult in these small areas.

General Information

Recognized by HJEO and OHJA with classes built to HJEO specifications.

Start time: 8:00 am in Ring 1; 8:30 am in Ring 2 (Management reserves the right to alter these at any time.)

Friday open schooling: 1:00 to 6:00 pm

Entry Information: Entry desk is open from 3:00 to 7:00 pm on Friday. Entries received after 6 pm on Friday October 23 will be charged a \$15 late fee. Show requirements: Appropriate attire – i.e., shirts with a collar, properly fitting breeches, and an ASTM approved helmet. Negative coggins

Ribbons: 1st through 6th

Stalls: Limited stalling available for \$35/night

Paddocks: Limited paddock space available for \$20/night per horse regardless how many horses share the paddock

Non-Showing Horses: Must enter and pay a \$25 non-showing fee in lieu of a division or class fee

Basic Show Entry Fees: To ensure our competitors' safety and for the smooth running of this event, every horse and rider combination is charged a \$20 Administration/Management fee plus a \$10 medic fee which will be charged to every horse/rider combination

Horse Welfare: The management and horse show officials reserve the right to limit showing and schooling if it is believed to be in the best interest of the horse

Showing not to be judged: Is available at management's discretion if time permits. In all cases, once an animal has appeared on a card "not to be judged" it is no longer eligible to be judged on that card thereafter with any entry number

Refunds: No refunds will be given, so please check your bill carefully

KJM Walk/Trot:

Open only to KJM academy students on KJM horses. In addition to Administration and Medic fees, these exhibitors are also responsible for the following:

Horse rental fee: \$10

Schooling fee: \$20

HJEO Schooling Division Specifications

Short Stirrup Hunter and Equitation (18")

Open to non-pro riders, age ten and under that:

- Have not competed in any classes with fences 2'6" or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or US Equestrian shows
- Have not been awarded a champion or reserve champion year end award by HJEO in Short Stirrup or Academy Short/Long Stirrup hunter or equitation

Trotting is not to be penalized. Cantering is prohibited in under saddle and flat classes.

This class is to be judged on manner of going, jumping style, correct pace, and organization.

No boxes, fill, or oxers.

Long Stirrup Hunter and Equitation (18")

Open to non-pro riders, age 11 and over that:

- Have not competed in any classes with fences 2'6" or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or US Equestrian shows
- Have not been awarded a champion or reserve champion year end award by HJEO in Short Stirrup or Academy Short/Long Stirrup hunter or equitation

Trotting is not to be penalized. Cantering is prohibited in under saddle and flat classes.

To be judged on manner of going, jumping style, correct pace, and organization.

No boxes, fill, or oxers.

Academy Short/Long Stirrup Hunter and Equitation (18")

Open to non-pro riders that:

- Have not competed in any classes with fences 2'6" or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or US Equestrian shows
- Have not been awarded a champion or reserve champion year end award by HJEO in Short Stirrup or Academy Short/long Stirrup hunter or equitation
- Are showing on an academy horse (as described in the HJEO constitution section 13)

Trotting is not to be penalized. Cantering is prohibited in under saddle and flat classes.

To be judged on manner of going, jumping style, correct pace, and organization. No boxes, fill, or oxers.

Open 2' Hunter and Equitation (2')

Hunter classes open to professional and non-professional riders. Trotting lead changes is not to be penalized. Cantering is prohibited in under saddle classes.

Equitation classes are open only to non professional riders who have not competed in any classes with fences 2'6" or higher at any HJEO, OHJA or USEF recognized shows.

This is an open division created for green horses and/or green riders not yet ready to move up to the 2'3" height.

The class is to be judged on manner of going, jumping style and suitability for the beginner hunter ring. Because this is an open division, correct leads and a consistent number of strides may be considered, but simple lead changes are not to be penalized.

No boxes, fill or oxers.

2'3" Very Low Hunter (2'3")

Open to all riders of any age.

No oxers.

Beginner Hunter and Equitation (2'3")

Open to non-professional riders that:

- Have not competed in any classes with fences 2'9" or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or US Equestrian recognized shows.
- Have not been awarded a champion or reserve champion year end award by HJEO in beginner or academy beginner hunter or equitation divisions.

This should be judged like all other hunter divisions, except that special consideration must be given to older, shorter-strided horses who can no longer do the step comfortably. On these types of horses, the added step may be acceptable at judge's discretion.

Flying changes are expected. No oxers.

Academy Beginner Hunter and Equitation (2'3")

Open to non-professional riders that:

- Have not competed in any classes with fences 2'6" or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or US Equestrian recognized shows.
- Have not been awarded a champion or reserve champion year end award by HJEO in beginner or academy beginner hunter or equitation divisions.
- Are showing on an academy horse (as described in HJEO constitution section 13)

Trotting lead changes is not to be penalized.

Same specs as beginner, except that simple changes are not to be penalized. This division was created for school horses, so that they may compete against each other on a more level playing field. In the event that the beginner and academy beginner are combined, the judge will be informed which horses qualify as academy horses, and those horses will be judged accordingly and will not be penalized for simple changes.

No oxers.

2'6" open hunter (2'6")

Open to all riders of any age.

Intermediate Hunter and Equitation (2'6")

Open to non-professional riders that:

- Have not competed in any classes with fences 3' or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or US Equestrian recognized shows.
- Have not been awarded a champion or reserve champion year end award by HJEO in Intermediate hunter or equitation divisions.

T.I.P. Special Thoroughbred Hunters (2'6")

Eligible horses must provide T.I.P. Numbers to event organizer with entry. For more information, visit www.tjctip.com. Must present proof of registration when checking in. Shall consist of three classes – two over fences and one under saddle. Jump courses should consist of at least seven jumps, to be judged on manners, pace and way of going unless otherwise noted. Under saddle class to be judged at the walk, trot and canter in both directions, and to be judged on manners, movement and way of going. Ribbons for first through sixth place for each class and Champion/Reserve ribbons will be provided. T.I.P. Championships Qualifying division.

Modified Children's/Adult Hunter and Equitation (2'9")

Open to non-professional riders.

Low Hunter and Non-Pro Equitation (3')

Open to all riders of any age. Equitation non-pro only.

HJEO Mini Medal

To be shown over a figure-eight course with fences to 2'6". Only equitation counts. The rider must be an HJEO member. This class is designed for beginner and intermediate riders. The winners shall be qualified for the annual ride-off.

Three exhibitors must be entered and show for the class to count.

Must be a member of the corresponding organization to enter.

Puddle Jumper

.75 to .85 Meter.

T.I.P Thoroughbred Hopeful Jumper

Fences 2'6". Eligible horses must provide T.I.P. Numbers to event organizer with entry. For more information, visit www.tjctip.com. Must present proof of registration when checking in. Ribbons for first through sixth place for two classes and a Champion/Reserve will be provided. T.I.P. Championships Qualifying division.

Schooling Jumper

Fences .90 to .95 Meter. Open to all riders of any age.

Non-Pro Mini Stirrup

Fences to be poles on the ground. Open to non-pro riders of any age. Same horse/ rider combination may not cross enter into any division 2ft or higher. Trotting not to be penalized. Flat classes to be walk/trot only.

Crossbar Hunter and Equitation

Crossbars will be made with the standards set at 18". Open to non-pro riders of any age. Same horse/rider combination may not cross enter into any division 2" or higher. Trotting not to be penalized. Flat classes to walk/trot only.

OHJA Classes

All riders must be OHJA members prior to competing in this class.

OHJA 3' Medal

Open to OHJA Junior and Amateur riders. At least three riders must complete the course, which consists of eight jumps with two changes of direction. Fences 3', spreads not to exceed 3'. Testing of top two to six riders required. USEF Test 1-14.

OHJA Mini Medal

To be shown over a figure-eight course with fences to 2'6". Equitation only to count. Rider must be an HJEO member. This class is designed for beginner and intermediate riders. The winners shall be qualified for the annual ride-off.

Three must be entered and shown to count.

Must be a member of the corresponding organization to enter.
